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




- The Philippines is a disaster-prone country
 - Typhoon Haiyan, flooding, storm surges, recent earthquakes
- Philippine Disaster Reduction and Management Act (R.A. 10121)
 - Section 14 DRRM in the school curricula
 - o In UP Diliman, this is present in the:
 - National Service Training Programs (NSTP)
 - Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS)
 - General Education course (Disaster Risk Mitigation, Adaptation, and Preparedness Strategies - DRMAPS)




Research Question

Is there a significant difference between UP Diliman undergraduate students with and without DRRM training in terms of their disaster-related knowledge, disaster preparedness and readiness behaviors, disaster adaptation, disaster awareness, and disaster risk perception?



Our Methodology



Review of Related Literature

Questionnaire with 5 components and 20 items from Tuladhar, Yatabe, Dahal, & Bhandary (2014; 2015)

Data Gathering

78 UP Diliman undergraduate students **with** DRRM training

vs

without DRRM training

Analysis

Used SPSS 23 and Qualyzer






Disaster-Related Knowledge of UP Diliman Undergraduate Students






Disaster Preparedness and Readiness of UP Diliman Undergraduate Students






Disaster Adaptation of UP Diliman Undergraduate Students






Disaster Awareness of UP Diliman Undergraduate Students









Conclusion

• **DRRM training is present** in some university students, but this is still **not sufficient**.

 Despite knowing importance of DRRM issues and concepts, these do not seem to translate to actions most of the time.

• There is a **need to revisit the DRRM programs in UP** and evaluate whether there is a need to improve them.

Recommendations





Policies should be disseminated

to all stakeholders in UP and should be strictly enforced.



Revisit how trainings on DRRM are conducted

to UP students, evaluate their effectivity, and revise accordingly.



Explore other means of training students

such as involving them in the creation of the programs and considering other forms of simulation-based models of training.



Encourage students to be more proactive

in knowing the DRRM policies in their localities (whether in UP or outside UP).
