World BOSAI Forum /International Disaster Risk Conference 2023 in Sendai Prospects



# Purpose

World BOSAI Forum activity started in the Tohoku region, which experienced Great East Japan Earthquake and Tsunami, and developed with a strong desire to prevent other people from suffering from natural disasters.

The Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030, a set of guidelines for activities related to disaster risk reduction, was adopted at The Third UN World Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction (WCDRR) which was held in Sendai in 2015. The Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction incorporates many concepts promoted by Japan, such as the importance of investment in disaster risk reduction and "Build Back Better" strategy. It can be said that Japan, as a world leader in the field of disaster risk reduction, has a responsibility to promote the implementation of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction. Furthermore, the activities of Japan and the Tohoku region in the process of recovery from the Great East Japan Earthquake and Tsunami that occurred on March 11, 2011, have attracted great attention all over the world.

While a variety of international conferences on disaster risk reduction including UN-led and academic conferences, took place around the world, there has been no international "forum" where specific solutions to reduce damage from disasters could be addressed, shared, and discussed.

Therefore, we decided to establish a "FORUM" in Sendai to propose solutions for disaster risk reduction from various perspectives of industry, government, academia, citizens, both domestic and international, to learn from each other, to create new values, and to promote the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction. This is what became known as the World BOSAI Forum.

The 1st World BOSAI Forum (2017) gathered Sendai City, Tohoku University, and various stakeholders (UN, international organizations, governments, private companies, media, NGOs/civil society organizations, universities and research institutes) to share information and discuss specific solutions for reducing disasters. The Forum also promoted the creation of a field for new partnerships and other initiatives.

At the 2<sup>nd</sup> World BOSAI Forum (2019), discussions were held on how to achieve Global Target E of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030 (to significantly increase the number of countries with national and local disaster reduction strategies by 2020). The results of the discussions about Build Back Better strategy, psychological recovery, coping with disasters caused by climate change, which has grown to be a serious problem in recent years, as well as the application of advanced technologies such as AI and IoT technologies in disaster management, were shared with the world.

The 3rd Forum will focus on the following two points.

First is the encouraging of more active participation from the general public and younger generations, and second is the increase of participation and interaction by holding thoroughly planned sessions on several topics, especially those related to integrated and interdisciplinary approaches. As the World BOSAI Forum we will share information on exact solutions for disaster reduction with the world, gained through the dialogue between industry, government, academia, and citizens, while putting an emphasis to the viewpoints of women and young people.

Japan is one of the countries most affected by frequent occurrence of natural disasters. Japan has bountiful experience and many solution strategies in regards to coping with natural disasters. These include not only Disaster Risk Reduction measures implemented in anticipation of disaster event and aimed to lessen the damage, but also provision of a heartfelt assistance to disaster victims to assure that people who have met with a disaster would recover quicker, and having disaster folklore which is an important part of Japanese culture. Japan has a mission of becoming a leader in Disaster Risk Reduction by sharing all of the above knowledge with the world.

At the Forum, we need to gather ideas from the diverse people and we need them to take on the leadership role in order to put together the extensive knowledge we have and to continue implementing solution strategies for the society while giving start to new partnerships. Therefore, to make this Forum a fascinating and fruitful experience we ask for the participation of as many people as possible and at the same time we kindly ask for everyone's support in this activity.

We understand that such requests are meant to be made face to face, but this time we humbly use this document to sincerely ask for your support Best wishes for your continued success in the future.



The week from the 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2023 to the 13<sup>th</sup> of March is going to be the Recovery Bosai week (working title), during which we plan to conduct various Bosai events in collaboration with Sendai City.

# Program

Session

Sessions will be held at the venue which can accommodate  $50 \sim 500$  people. We plan to give 90 min for each session's time slot. (we expect only half of the venue's seating capacity to be occupied due to the use of measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19)

Poster Session

We will accept Poster presentation applications in line with the main theme. <u>A total of</u> <u>around 50 posters</u> are expected to be presented at the venue. We also plan to arrange a Poster award.

## Flash Talk Presentation

We plan to arrange a separate panel inside the venue for 15 to 40 min presentations of individual speakers who are not willing to host the entire session, but would like to share information about their good practices.

We expect around 30 groups to take part in this activity.

## Registration for the Participation

This Forum strives to be a place where industry-government-academia groups and organizations and even general visitors can participate freely in organized activities, share information, have discussions and build good relationships. We aim to conduct just management without giving special treatment to organizations which provide financial donations. For that reason, we use registration fees from Forum's participants (common 3-day pass with early registration discount: 50000 yen), exhibition fees paid by organizations and companies taking part in the Sessions, donations and material assistance from Sendai City, host of the event, to pay the expenses of the Forum's preparation, planning, activities arrangement.

On the other hand, we believe that it is also important to increase citizen participation. That is why we set up a free registration system for a large number of citizens, students, high school students whose occupation or specialty is not related to Disaster Risk Reduction.

We hope that we managed to get our message across and we really hope to have a lot of people register for the participation in the event. Registration for the participation is scheduled to open in the middle of October 2022.
